PREMIERSHIP MATCH REPORT

B Grade Match Report Grand Final vs Traralgon West @ Roger Ries Oval

Heading out to Toongabbie, on what was a lovely day for cricket, we set about snagging the first win of the day - getting our gear into the Home changerooms first. Probably two and a half times bigger than the Away changerooms, it gave us all a chance to spread out on the numerous couches and relax before making our way out to look at the wicket.

After some pitch inspection and excited chats with teammates and opposition, both captains were called back out to the middle, to talk with the umpires and to have a toss. Rory lost (8 wins-9 losses for the season) the toss and Traralgon West elected to bat first on what looked to be a decent batting wicket. From chatting with the A grade boys during the week, we knew that from their experience out here, the odd ball bowled back of a length tended to keep low.

Starting us off from the southern end was Ben Hagley. Coming off 3 wickets in the Semi-Final, you can probably imagine he was eager to add to that tally. In partnership with Ben from the northern end was Left armer Nick Miller. With official One-Day conditions, Nick had to adapt early, with his late in-swingers to the right-handed batsmen sneaking down leg side for wides.

After 2 overs from Ben, Rory bought himself on for a change of pace. A few wayward overs from Rory and Nick saw the bowling change at both ends, with Nick subbing off the field and bringing on Brad Foster. The score at this point was 0/37 off 8. First up in this series of changes was Ace Wilhelm from the southern end. Ace's first ball was a full toss on leg, that was clipped low to Brads right at short fine leg. Unfortunately, it slapped into his right hand then onto the grass. What would have been an amazing catch ended up saving 2-3 valuable runs.

Jason Motta was the change at the Northern end, and it wouldn't take long before we had the breakthrough we were after. On his 3rd ball, Motts hit that back of a length spot and Veteran Brenton Howe, went back to pull, only to find the ball go under his bat and clip his off stump. No one could stop the freight train that was Jason Motta, celebrating down to where you might find a fly slip. Who would have thought that waiting over 2 decades to play in a grand final would have the big man excited.
Traralgon west - 1/41.

The next few overs went by uneventfully, with Ace and Motta drying up the run rate. It was Ace's 3rd over where we would have our next big break through. Bowling a shorter ball, whether it was a deliberate slow ball by ace or slowed up off the wicket I'm not sure, danger man Daniel Cropley (coming off a century in the Semi Final) mistimed the shot out towards deep square leg. In what could arguably be called the catch of the year given the circumstances, Tim Derham running in from the large Toongabbie boundary did what only he could do. Covering close to 15-20 meters, diving towards the oncoming ball, at full stretch, Turtle managed to catch the mistimed shot, just before it hit the ground.
Traralgon West - 2/47.

Having lost both opening batsmen with 2 quick wickets, runs became very hard to score, with the next 4 overs only going for 2 runs, thanks to some tight lines and lengths and us CATS boys being up and about in the field. Motts would be the next to snatch another, bowling a straighter one to CLV Batting Average winner Sam Varsaci, who pulled it straight around the corner to Evan at backwards square leg, dismissing him for 1.

If we couldn't stop Motta earlier, there was absolutely nothing any of us could do to stop him now. Enter the umpires – First warning for inappropriate language (Jason). Turns out you can celebrate a little too hard.

Traralgon West - 3/50.

Not to be outdone, it would only take a further 8 balls, all scoreless, for Ace to snag his second. A mistimed cover drive would see Mark Williams (who made 76 against us in a previous game) caught at short cover by an excellent sharp catch from Jason Motta.

Traralgon West - 4/50

There's a cliché in cricket – ‘Another one before drinks’, which is exactly what we managed to do. After having an LBW appeal turned down earlier on in the game, Ace bowled one of the many change up deliveries that he has in his arsenal. A superb off cutter, nipping back in past the inside edge of the batsman, impacting in line with off stump. Out LBW

Traralgon West - 5/52

Taking drinks at the end of the 23 over, Traralgon West sat at 5/53. After a brief chat about keeping out foot on the throat, we made our way back into the field. After an over of out-swingers from Motta, there was a change of bowling at the other end. Veteran Brad Foster into the attack. Unfortunately, it was to be a very short over, with Brad doing his calf after 3 dot balls. Young Evan came into the attack to finish off Brad's over, conceding 1 off his first 3 balls. Coming on for his last over of the day, Motta's first ball held its line, nipped back off the seam and had the batsman Out LWB. Despite the Umpires trying to censor Jason earlier, it was to no avail. Motta went onto finish the over strong, with a wicket maiden.

Traralgon West - 6/56

Coming back onto bowl after completing Brads over, the Traralgon West batsmen must have thought that young Evan might be the bowler to target to try dig them out of the hole that they had found their way into. Unfortunately for them, they would only find their way that little bit deeper, with the batsman trying to cut a wider ball from Evan and spooning it to Vaughan at Point. More celebrations ensued; young Evan happy to have one against his name.

Traralgon West - 7/57

With Motta's Brilliant spell of bowling being forced to come to an end, that gave our leading wicket taker and off spinner Vaughan a chance to come into the attack. Having set about his work and keeping the pressure on, our next breakthrough would be on the 1st ball of his 2nd over. A big old mix up of communication between batsmen would see Traralgon West Captain Luke Phillips, cut the ball to backward point and call No. Young and eager was the non-striker, calling Yes Yes, only to be sent back. Maybe it was luck? Maybe it was the 30 minutes of practise we spent on the Thursday night prior, doing this exact drill? Picking up the ball at point and throwing down the bowlers end stumps. Either way, Nick did not disappoint. A clean pick up and good throw, saw the stumps rattle and the young batsman on his way.

Traralgon West – 8/61

With a fresh Batsman at the Non strikers end and things not changing before the end of the over, Rory made the decision to switch out young Evan for the CLV Bowling Average winner, Marty Anthofer. Well, in a spell that would only lessen that average even more, it seemed everything was going our way that day. Marty's first ball certainly wasn't the best he's bowled all season, but none the less, the short, wide ball was chopped back onto the stumps and the number 10 was sent packing for a golden duck.

Traralgon West – 9/65

With the pressure on the Traralgon West captain and the number 11, a combination of sensible batting and big shots would see them climb their way to 84, before Captain Rory, who had replaced Marty at the southern end in order to pepper the number 11, would see him trying to drive over the top, skying it to Evan at Mid-Off, who held his nerve as the wind had pick up, taking the catch and ending Traralgon West's innings after 36.2 over.

What ended up being one of the best bowling innings we'd had this season, everyone was rapt that we were chasing a low total but were also aware the job was not done. Having made low totals look hard to chase this year and having just seen how the deck was playing, we knew this wasn't going to be an easy task. After a lovely spread, put on by hosts Toongabbie, our openers padded up and found their way out into the middle.

After a dominant opening partnership and some big hitting in the Semi-Final out at the Cattery, the boys knew that today was going to be a whole different kettle of fish. Josh would be the first to fall in the 5th over, trying to cut a short, wide ball that was there to punish. Unfortunately, after having scored a series of 2's through the covers, T-West had a sweeper out at a deep Cover-Point and Josh managed to pick the man out, leaving us 1/11.

2 overs later, Marty would also be sent on his way, judged out LBW, the ball somehow hitting him between where the top of the cane finishes in the front of the pad and where the knee roll starts, a painful shin still hurting on mad Monday. This left us at 2/19. Would some of us be lying if we said we weren't thinking about our issues chasing small totals, probably.

Enter Turtle. Having scored over 130 runs in his previous two hits, Turtle set about rebuilding with Rory, absorbing all pressure sent his way. Making a 2 off 21 deliveries in a valuable 16 run partnership with Rory, Turtle advanced down the wicket to a full toss from Traralgon West's off spinner. Whist he got to it, he bunted it straight to mid-wicket sending him on his way. This took us to 3/35.

Headed out to the crease to join Rory was future man of the match Jason Motta and the boys set about dwindling the chase total over the next 15 overs. Despite telling others to make sure they went forward on this pitch, Rory was dismissed bowled, going back to one that cut a bit and kept a little low. With the score at 4/73, Rory left the field after a captain's knock of 33 off 69, staying patient and waiting for the runs to come to him.

Veteran cricketer Ace Wilhelm joined his fellow veteran Jason in the middle and they went about chasing the final 12 runs needed to win. As we got closer to the total, everyone started to line up on the sidelines, ready to run onto the field to celebrate. With the scores tied on 84, it was Jason who hit the bowler over mid-on, running the first run with arms and bat raised. After coming back for the second, everyone streamed onto the field to celebrate and congratulate one another on capping off a successful season with a premiership.

As mentioned earlier, Motts was named Man of the Match with 22* off 55 and 3/9 of 9 with 4 maidens. Ace also fished up with 3/9 off 8 overs in what was a superb bowling partnership that set up the win for us. To go from 0/40 to having Traralgon West out for 84, was nothing short of a herculean effort by the team, and the presence of mind to stay calm under pressure by our senior batsmen (Rory, Turtle, and Motts) in a tough chase, sealed the deal for all.

Thankyou to all who came to support us throughout the day and back out at the Cattery, later that night. It was great to see so many familiar faces there to help us celebrate.
